2021-22 SCHOOL YEAR REGIONAL COVID PLAN

The Catholic schools of Hamilton County have collaborated on safety measures for the start of the 2021-2022 school year. These were developed with recommendations from the Diocese, CDC, and Indiana State Dept of Health. All measures are subject to change as expert guidance evolves.

- Masses with the entire student body will be welcomed back this year!
- Enhanced cleaning measures in the classrooms and schools will continue.
- Students who exhibit the following symptoms should remain home from school: Temperature of 100.4 or higher; loss of taste or smell; sore throat; diarrhea, nausea, or vomiting; headache; congestion or runny nose; and cough or difficulty breathing.
- Masks will be optional for all students, staff, and visitors.
- Students who are not fully vaccinated will need to quarantine if they are identified as a close contact with a positive case.
- Students who are fully vaccinated will not need to quarantine due to close contact with a positive case. Parents will be notified and should monitor students for symptoms.
- Remote learning will be provided for students absent due to COVID.
- Each individual school will be sharing more specific information as the start of school approaches.
